

Privacy Policy

General:

- Unless mutually agreed no delay or modification to procedure by a party will be deemed a waiver of that, or any other, right or remedy.
- This privacy policy is governed by and interpreted according to English law. All disputes arising under this privacy policy are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

How we collect your information:

- When you provide it to us by contacting us, requesting a brochure or information via our website.
- From using our website cookies.

Personal information we collect:

- Name, contact details, including telephone number and email address.
- When browsing our website this may include your IP address, location, browser type and operating system, referral source, page views and navigation paths through our website.

How we use your personal data:

- We use your data so that we can contact you with any further information, to improve our services and website through analysis, and for advertising purposes.
- Whenever you are required to submit data, you have the right to withhold the use of this data. This can include:
 - Use of your data for marketing purposes.
 - Sharing data with third parties.

How we secure your personal data:

- We take appropriate measures to encrypt and safely store all data that we collect through suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures. We only grant access to your personal information where necessary and don't sell your personal information to any third parties.

Accessing your personal information and your rights

Your rights in relation to your personal information:
